When working through a project using a PBL Mindset, use these questions to help transform your learning.




Challenge
What is the guiding question? What am I trying to do?



Inquiry
What do I already know about this? What do I not know about this challenge? Where do I go to find the information? What do I need to know?




Deliverable
How do I show that I have demonstrated learning? What is the expectation for me to show my learning?



Create
Where do I start? What comes next? What materials and equipment do I need for my project? How can I show my project to others?



Collaboration
Who do I have to work with on this project? Who might be able to help me learn?



Reflection
What did I do well? What could I do better? How was this successful? What did I know now that I didn't know when I started?
